



Ice Technician/Zamboni Driver/Operations

Description:

This position is responsible for performing rink resurfacing at designated times and performing maintenance tasks at the Aviator Sports and Events Center. This position works independently under general supervision of the Executive Director of Ice Operations and Facility Director.

Several schedules are open - Monday-Friday evenings (time varies between 4pm-11pm), Saturday and Sunday daytime and evening shifts. Must be flexible with working evenings and weekends.

Essential Functions

- Responsible for operating and driving the Zamboni ice resurfacing machine, edge conditioning, and other motorized equipment.
- Maintain accurate records of ice cuts, blade changes and preventative maintenance.
- Assist with annual ice building and painting of the rinks.
- Provide staff daily ice rink maintenance schedules; ice skate sharpening, skate rental booth and public skating.
- Performs custodial work in offices and building interior/exterior to include sweeping, mopping, vacuuming, and scrubbing/buffing machines.
- Managing staff to include the rink monitors, skate guards, and skate booth attendants; Assist in scheduling staff with attention to the payroll budget.
- Ensuring safety protocols are being followed by patrons and staff on/off the rink.
- Answers inquiries and communicates information regarding programs and facility policy, at times under stressful conditions which may require exceptional independent judgment and discretion.
- Investigate, analyze and resolve operational problems and customer complaints.
- Administrative office work for the Hockey department to include invoicing clients, updating records in DASH and excel spreadsheet, follow-up on returning calls and other administrative/office work assigned by Hockey Executive Director.
- Assist with event set-ups and breakdowns.
- Communicate regularly with maintenance staff about repair and maintenance needs on all equipment and assigned jobs.
- Relate to public and to customers in a professional, courteous and respectful manner, appropriately responding to complaints.
- Assist with sweeping outdoors and removing snow or perform other incidental seasonal tasks.
- Ability to learn to drive large equipment.
- Assist with the outdoor fields set-up for soccer, football, lacrosse, etc. games.

- Empty trash on the outdoor fields when needed.

Qualifications/Requirements:

Must be able to work evenings (through 11pm) and weekend hours. Some scheduled shifts may include holidays. Must be able to perform multiple tasks in a fast-paced environment, often independently. Able to lift 25-50 lbs without any limitations. Experience driving a Zamboni and working with facility equipment.
